Nordiq Ski Nationals

The 97th Nordiq Canada Ski Nationals will take place from March 17-23, 2025 at the Canmore Nordic Centre, in Canmore AB. The Nordiq Canada Ski Nationals are a Tier 1 - FIS-sanctioned Nordiq Cup Event. The competition also includes the Canadian College and University National Championships (CCUNC) and the Canadian Para Nordic Championships. More than 800 senior, junior and para-nordic skiers will compete in sprints, distance races and team events.

This year we have three Fernie Nordic Racers athletes attending Ski Nationals 2025: **Mae Elson**, **Tate Elson** and **Ella Fuller**.
